

About registration

Payment for participation in the Marathon

The amount of payment for natural persons wishing to participate in the race is 20 AZN. Those who join as corporately, can apply by writing an e-mail at **info@marathon.az**.

Since the Heydar Aliyev Foundation pays for students 'participation in the marathon, they will not pay during registration.

Registration

Persons over 18 years of age can visit registration points in shopping malls of Baku ("28 Mall", "Ganjlik Mall", "Deniz Mall") or the website of "Baku Marathon - 2025". www.marathon.az when they apply. During registration, it is necessary to fill out the appropriate form, submit a copy of the identity card (students at the same time a copy of the student card) and pay the established fee for participation.

Rules of participation

Persons aged 18 and older can participate in the race.

The participant's race number allows to identify his personality and cannot be changed, replaced, or sold to another person. Selling, exchanging race numbers is prohibited, and if this happens, it may result in the participant being excluded from the race or not being allowed into future events.

The registration process ends at the time to be announced on the website of the competition. Exceptional cases after registration time is not possible. Only the organizers have the right to change the time of the competition.

On the day of the race, participants should not be under the influence of alcohol and drugs.

Non-admission of the participant to the race

Any participant who cannot get to the Start line on time is not allowed to compete and his payment is not refunded.

Cancellation and change of race

Organizers can change the timing of the race at any time. Changes, for example, changing the start time, etc. are agreed with the participants in advance.

Exclusion

- 1. Supervisors are able to exclude any participant from the procedure.
- 2. Exclusion can take place in the following cases:

- The participant will change his number with another racer without prior consent of the organizer;
- If the participant deviates from the designated route;
- If the participant does not follow the instructions of the race official or if he uses offensive actions and statements against the race officials, volunteers or the audience.

Race day

- 1. Participants must follow the instructions given by all race officials, as well as staff, volunteers, medical staff, security and city officials before, during and after the race .
- 2. Each participant must be provided with a race number written on the front of the shirt and visible throughout the entire race.
- 3. Participants must warn the organizers of the competition about health problems or medications they are taking.
- 4. Participants must start the race at the officially announced start time.

Responsibility

- 1. Participation in the race is the personal participation of the participant.
- 2. The organizer is not responsible for lost items and damage caused.
- 3. The organizer is not responsible for the loss or damage caused to the participant.
- 4. The organizer is not responsible for the behavior of the audience and a third party.
- 5. The organizer is not responsible for cases arising from food and beverage products (allergies, etc.) provided on the day of the race.

Prohibited items

- Items that may pose a threat or have a "dual use" may be considered dangerous (for example, hammers, saws, sharp-pointed, cutting tools, etc.);
- Flammable liquids, fuels, firecrackers, toxic chemicals and explosives;
- Large parcels;
- Opaque trash cans and plastic containers;
- Animals / pets;
- Folding chairs, folding camping chairs and tables of any type;
- Liquid containers with a capacity of more than one liter;
- Suitcases and roller suitcases.
